Temporary Closure of Michaelhouse

Sadly, the Trustees of Michaelhouse, in line with Government and Church of England guidance, have closed Michaelhouse and it will remain closed, at least until the government lifts restrictions on gatherings in public places.



Once that has happened, Michaelhouse will seek to serve the community in all the ways it has in the past until the Coronavirus pandemic struck and these drastic measures had to be taken. Our key concern is to ensure that the pandemic is contained, and we wish to ensure that we fulfil our responsibilities.

We are most grateful to all those who have supported Michaelhouse, its aims and objectives over the years, and those who have been customers of the Michaelhouse Cafe, and we would welcome your continued support. It will be most needed as we seek to resume our work after this crisis has passed and the world resumes its normal course. This remains a time of considerable concern and uncertainty for those who worked in the cafe and the Centre and we would ask you to keep them in your prayers and thoughts.
